George W. Trapp Company Energy Tax Credit Certification Letter

This manufacturer's certification statement is the documentation necessary to claim the energy tax credit in accordance with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. To receive a tax credit on the purchase price of a Trapp aluminum storm door:

1. Purchase and install the qualifying product between the dates of Jan 1, 2009 and December 31, 2010. The product must be installed over an entry door with a U-factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) of 0.30 or below and meet the prescriptive criteria established by the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC). The storm door must have the glass insert installed. The tax credit applies to the purchase price of the storm door; it does not include installation costs. The tax credit is for the homeowner's principal residence only.
2. Download or print the certification letter below and save it with the receipt for the product. These documents should be retained with tax information for records only. The documents are not required to be sent with tax forms.

Trapp storm doors that qualify for the tax credit (all models listed qualify nationwide):

108; 120; 140; 220; 308; 320; 1508; Borderlite; Brass Diamond; Patina Diamond; Craftsman; Crossbuck; 100; Ovalite; Defendoor; 200; Self Storing; 108 Self Storing.

George W. Trapp Company certifies that all Trapp storm door models listed in this statement are in compliance with the IECC U-factor requirements to qualify for 2009-2010 energy tax credits listed under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Under IRS Notice 2009-53, a storm door is an eligible building envelope component when it, in combination with the exterior entry door over which it is installed, has a U-factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) of 0.30 or below, and meets the prescriptive criteria established by the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC).
